The Oregon Department of Transportation, in collaboration with Klamath County and the City of Klamath Falls, has begun work on an Interchange Area Management Plan (IAMP) for the OR 66/US 97 Interchange.

The interchange area currently has street connectivity, safety, and access issues. The IAMP will plan for the long term vision of the interchange area by identifying improvements to the interchange and the roadways in the vicinity of the interchange. In addition, the IAMP will address mobility, bicycle and pedestrian facilities and land use.

To kick-off this process, the project team is holding a public workshop focused on brainstorming ideas for what the area might look like in the future. Participants will get an overview of the project, learn basics in "Interchange Design 101," and have a chance to say (and draw!) how they think the interchange should be developed.
