GEORGE NURSE

BORN JUNE 4, 1820 IN NEW YORK CITY

CITY FATHER – ARRIVED 1866

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

1867 OPENED TRADING POST OPERATED FERRY ACROSS LINK RIVER

1869 BUILT BRIDGE ACROSS LINK RIVER 1872 PLANTED APPLE TREES – SIGN OF PERMANENCY

1878 PLATTED TOWN AND CALLED IT LINKVILLE

1880 HE AND PARTNER PLATTED WEST LINKVILLE

FIRSTS HE WAS FIRST POSTMASTER, FIRST HOTEL KEEPER, FIRST LIVERY STABLE OPERATOR, AND GAVE THE SETTLEMENT IT'S FIRST SCHOOL. HE DONATED LAND FOR THE FIRST COURTHOUSE AND FIRST CEMETERY.

MOVED IN 1883 TO YREKA, CALIFORNIA LINKVILLE RENAMED KLAMATH FALLS IN 1893 DIED IN YREKA ON NOVEMBER 26, 1895 BURIED AT EVERGREEN CEMETERY IN YREKA, SECTION SE, BLOCK 37, LOT 1, SPACE 1
